Currently she shares her home with 3 Golden Retrievers, 2 Labrador Retrievers and a Shih-tzu. Connie's most well know dogs are her Lab, FC-AFC-OTCH *Ezra* and her Golden FC-AFC-OTCH *Eli*.

The Clevelands are much in demand as seminar instructors throughout the United States and Canada and have traveled to South America and Japan to share their expertise with other training groups. They enjoy helping owners understand that dog training can make sense.
