# All handlers should check in at the Test Secretary by 8:00 a.m. at the <u>Test Headquarters</u>, which will be inside the N.E.T. Camping Resort

- Running order will be determined by random draw at the home of the Test Secretary one hour after closing. A catalogue and running order list will be provided to entrants on the day of the test.
- Standard CKC Rosettes will be awarded to all qualifying dogs at the tailgate on Saturday; at the completion of each stake on Sunday.
- Ducks will be used for both land and water in all Tests.
- > Shotguns may not necessarily be used at all stakes.
- For Hunt Tests, all handlers MUST wear dark or camouflage clothing
- Please check in with the Marshall upon arrival at your stake.
- Dogs are expected to run in numerical order at all stakes. If a conflict arises due to participation in another stake, it is the responsibility of the Handler to notify the Marshall of the conflict at each stake.
- Handlers may be required to handle a gun during the Hunt test. Proper gun safety is considered part of the test.
- > Please note the use of cell phones is prohibited in the vicinity of the tests.
- It is the responsibility of the Entrant/Handler to be familiar with the CKC Rules and Regulations for Hunt Tests.
- "It shall be the duty and obligation of the test giving club to see that a Judge, Club Official, Volunteer or any participant at a Hunt Test held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind."
- Refunds will <u>only</u> be given for bitches <u>in season</u>. A Veterinarian's Certificate must be submitted to the Test Secretary before the start of the test.
- The Golden Retriever Club of Greater Toronto is not responsible or liable for any injuries incurred to either handler or dog entered in this test.

#### DIRECTIONS TO NET CAMPING RESORT

**FROM TORONTO:** Take the QEW to Niagara, Exit #57 (Victoria Ave) Vineland take the off ramp, to a stop sign. At the stop sign turn right. This takes you to a set of lights, turn left onto Victoria Ave (Regional Road #24). Follow Victoria Ave. 12km South and the resort will be on your left hand side.

**FROM NIAGARA FALLS:** Head West on Lundy's Lane (Hwy 20) for 20km then turn right onto Regional Road #24 (Victoria Ave.) travel 4km and the resort is on your right hand side.
