- 10) Acceptance of the Agenda. Accepted as provided.

- 13) Old Business:
 - a) Awards program update (Gord Kerr). Gord went through the list of submissions and had some questions about some of the names and whether some of the info people submitted is correct. He presented the draft plaque and banners to the directors for comment as they need to go in for burning soon. Some of the options for the configuration were discussed. This included how to show the kennel name, member's names, and the date when first joined. The other issue discussed was the logo. Gord had to convert the logo into a different format for burning. He also had to change the font type and text size as it did not transform well from the png file. The directors approved the changes to the logo as presented.
 - b) Revision of Constitution, By-Laws, Code of Ethics (Gord Kerr). Tabled for presentation to the membership. Due to difficulties coordinating the effort, the revised version is not ready in time for this year's AGM.
 - c) 2009 Obedience Trial Report Feb 8-9, 2009 (Danuta Booth). Financial statement received from Bruce Russell. See attached. See General meeting minutes.
 - d) 2010 CKC Priority Dates (Michele Rebelo). No update, but paperwork was submitted to CKC by Bruce.
 - e) Health Clinic April 2-5, 2009 (Michele Rebelo). Have about 300 procedures booked. The number of eyes is down from last year, although the Thursday will be busy. There are quite a few PRA procedures booked.
 - f) Connie Cleveland Seminar May 9-10, 2009 (Carol Lee). There has not been a very big response to date. There are 8 coming with dogs at \$220 and 6 without dogs at \$160, for a total of \$2720. If no more participants apply, we would lose about \$1000 plus Connie's meal and transport expenses. If the event is cancelled, we would still have to pay for the airfare, and we would lose some on deposits. Nancy and Carol have contacted hundreds of people, but there has been very poor response, even from Club members. Part of the issue can be that the event is being held on Mother's Day; other reasons could include the economy. All of the observers are from the Peterborough Dog Club and their Club is paying for them. Carol has set the start time at 9:00 a.m. so that some people can consider driving back and forth rather than staying over in Barrie.

- g) AGM April 18, 2009 (Anna Morison). Everything is booked. Last year the fee was \$25 with wine included. This year it was booked without wine. This year it was booked to start from 4:00 pm (meeting), with dinner at 6:00 pm. The meal will cost about \$52/person and appetizer snacks. The directors discussed whether the banquet should be fully paid for by the Club or partly subsidized. Anna Morison made a directors motion that the Club will pay for the dinners, not including alcoholic beverages, of all members. Non-member guests will be charged \$25. The directors then discussed whether they will stand as directors/officers for next year.

The Golden Retriever Club of Greater Toronto is well on its way to hosting a very successful National Specialty in Stratford, Ontario this July! I am hoping that the GRCGT will be willing to share their best practices with other affiliate clubs planning to host the National Specialty. We would all be interested, for example, in knowing what steps were involved in securing that tremendous corporate funding for the Specialty.

As the GRCGT will likely attest, the key to hosting a successful National Specialty is based on thorough planning and organization. In order to ensure maximum time for such planning, the following four-year cycle is being presented for your action:

National Specialty Year

Affiliate Club Hosting the Specialty

* The time line for planning and hosting the 2011 National Specialty is particularly critical, given that we are looking at approximately 16 months away. As a suggestion, perhaps two Clubs would consider jointly hosting the 2011 Specialty.

Affiliate Clubs are asked to choose in which of the four years you will commit to hosting a National Specialty in your region. The GRCC will provide as much support as you need to plan and organize the event and we can draw from the experience of the current Specialty hosts as well.

In particular, we encourage the Ottawa Valley Golden Retriever Club to commit to hosting the National Specialty in one of the four years in the cycle. Our records indicate that the last time the OVGRC hosted the Specialty was in 1999. Several of the affiliate clubs have hosted the Specialty twice within that time period.

As a reminder, one of the obligations to maintain status as a GRCC affiliate club is the requirement to host the National Specialty.

Please forward your chosen year to Christine Kobler by June 1, 2010. Once we have confirmed commitments, we can start to assist in the planning process.
